Annex II

Possible contact groups at the COPs/ExCOPs meetings:

1. The following contact groups may be established during the two-week meeting, with the understanding that they do not have to work simultaneously and that some of them may not be necessary or may be short-lived. The total number of contact groups meeting at any one time would need to be limited to ensure that there is adequate opportunity for the interests of all delegations to be factored into the discussions.

(a) Simultaneous extraordinary meetings of the conferences of the parties:

- Joint contact group on synergies, including the budget

The joint contact group under the simultaneous extraordinary meetings of the conferences of the parties <u>could</u> <u>start on Sunday, 28 April</u> and meet as needed throughout the two-week period. It would be encouraged to complete its work by close of business on Wednesday, 8 May and, if possible, not later than by close of business on Thursday, 9 May (if more than one contact group were to be established for budget and for synergies, only one group would meet at any given time).

(b) Simultaneous sessions of the ordinary meetings of the conferences of the parties

- Joint contact group on technical assistance and financial resources
- Joint contact group(s) on compliance, to possibly include other legal matters

Joint contact groups established under the simultaneous sessions of the ordinary meetings of the conferences of the parties <u>could start on Monday, 29 April</u> and could meet as needed throughout the two-week period. The groups would be encouraged to address convention-specific issues during the timeframe of each ordinary COP and to complete their work according to the following schedule:

- Stockholm Convention-specific issues are to be completed, if possible, by close of business on Wednesday, 1 May and not later than by midday on Thursday, 2 May;
- Basel Convention-specific issues are to be completed, if possible, by close of business on Saturday, 4 May and not later than by midday on Monday, 6 May;
- Rotterdam Convention-specific issues are to be completed, if possible, by close of business on Wednesday, 8 May and not later than by midday on Thursday, 9 May.

Contact groups on the above issues could also be established during the individual COP meetings later in the two-week period.

(c) Conference of the Parties to the Stockholm Convention:

- Contact group on listing of chemicals
- Friends of the President group on effectiveness evaluation

Contact groups under the separate ordinary meeting of the Stockholm Convention <u>could start on Tuesday</u>, <u>30 April</u> and would be encouraged to complete their work by close of business on Wednesday, 1 May and, if possible, not later than by midday on Thursday, 2 May.

(d) Conference of the Parties to the Basel Convention:

- Contact group on technical matters
- Contact group on strategic matters (CLI ESM framework and OEWG)

Contact groups under the separate ordinary meeting of the Basel Convention <u>could start on Friday, 3 May</u> and would be encouraged to complete their work, if possible, by close of business on Saturday, 4 May and not later than by midday on Monday, 6 May.

(e) Conference of the Parties to the Rotterdam Convention:

- Contact group on listing of chemicals

Contact groups under the separate ordinary meeting of the Rotterdam Convention <u>could start on Tuesday</u>, <u>7 May</u> and would be encouraged to complete their work, if possible, by close of business on Wednesday, 8 May and not later than by midday on Thursday, 9 May.

Pre-meetings on Saturday, 27 April:

2. Saturday before the opening of the meetings, pre-meetings will be scheduled. These include a joint meeting of the bureaux and regional group meetings.
